Here are the **Release Notes** for Beta 2.5, an interim release of RDSS2 on the way to the Beta3 release before finally releasing RDSS 2.0. To get the complete documentation so far of the RDSS2 Beta, please also read the previous Release Notes for RDSS2 Beta2 (www.rdss2.com/r2b2).

<u>Downloading</u>, <u>Installing</u>, <u>Folder and File Organization</u>

Here are the Download particulars:

Note: for discussion purposes, the current version of RDSS (Version 0.99.2) is referred to as **RDSS1**. RDSS 2.0 is referred to as **RDSS2**.

Download and Save the RDSS2 Install program to your computer (do not choose 'Run' in your browser download Dialog - choose 'Save' to your computer).

Run the Installer program you downloaded (named Rdss2Install.Beta2.5-03.exe). If you have never installed RDSS2 before on a computer, this installs RDSS 2.0 to a default folder named RDSS2. If you have already installed an earlier version of RDSS2 on a computer, this install simply updates the older version. Installing RDSS2 does not affect RDSS1 - they can both be installed and running at the same time. In Beta Version 2 (as with Beta1), RDSS2 uses the same database as RDSS1. If you need to uninstall RDSS2 (or RDSS1) it won't affect the other, or the shared database.

Note: in order to run RDSS2, you need to have installed RDSS1 on your computer first.

Note: if you need to revert back to the previous Beta1 version for any reason, either uninstall RDSS2 or, more simply, delete the EXE, PBD and DLL files from your RDSS2 folder, then re-install the older Beta1 version. (The installer will NOT overwrite newer files with older files, so to reinstate an older version, you have to delete the newer files first).

A new RDSS2 icon will appear on your Desktop:



Make sure you can tell which icon launches RDSS2 and which launches RDSS1! RDSS2 lives in c:\RDSS2 folder. RDSS1 lives in c:\RDSS folder.

The rest of this document will simply describe the changes and additions to the software since Beta 2. To get the complete documentation so far of the RDSS 2.0, please also read the previous Release Notes for RDSS2 Beta2 (www.rdss2.com/r2b2).

Quick Summary of Changes and Additions to Beta2.5

- 1. RDSS Desktop: added link to Track Information (DRF); Sidebar can be hidden using red arrows left of RDSS Desktop Tab (or Desktop button); Exit Button left-click to Exit, right-click to Restart; added button for Windows SnippingTool (for screen captures).
- 2. PP Original Screen Layout: enhanced Layoff and interval separators; Adjusted SR displayed in graphical, colour-coded format; Adjusted data can be hidden; horizontal scrollbars available via Configure screen (i.e. if screen width insufficient for display); removed 'Matchup and Form' Tabs
- 3. Card Summary Screen: added Today's Changes/Scratches button; added Assemble **all** races on card button; Assembled races are highlighted
- 4. Entries Screen: Expand button shows Jockey and Trainer (more to come)
- 5. Data Centre: layout reorganized
- 6. Configure Tab: layout reorganized; obsolete items removed; added horizontal scrollbar switch
- 7. Registration Tab: layout reorganized
- 8. Paceline Selection Strategy screen: layout reorganized

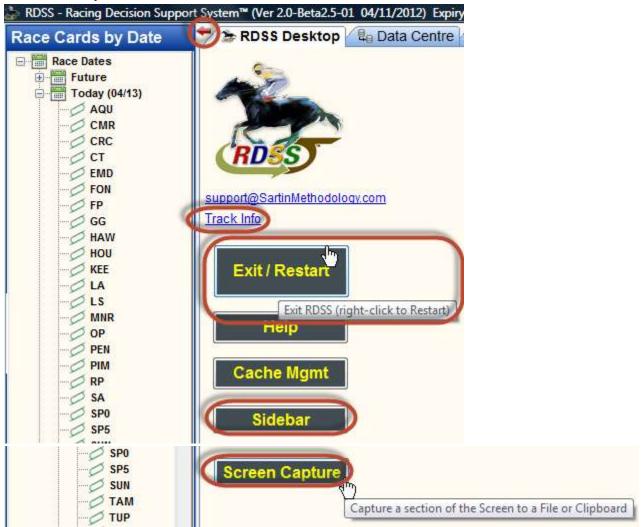

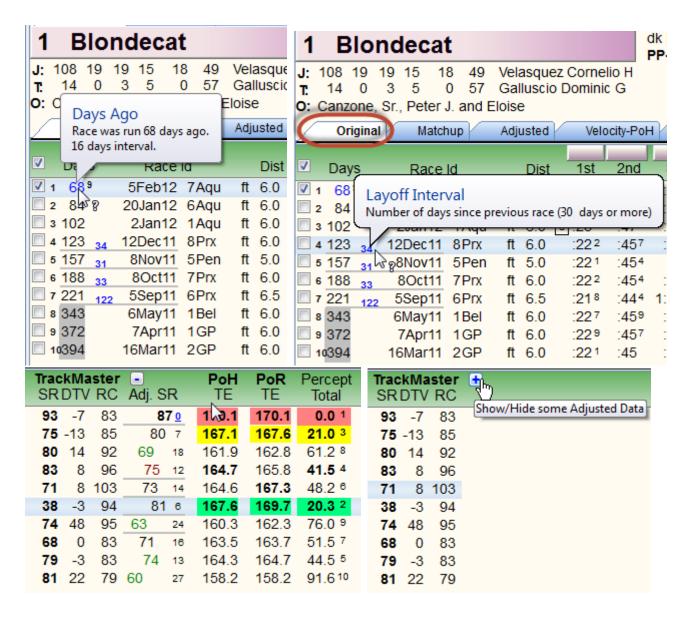
Changes and Additions to RDSS2 Beta2.5

1. RDSS Desktop



- -click the **red arrow** to the left of the RDSS Desktop Tab to Hide or Show the Sidebar (for example if you need more screen width); or use the Sidebar button; the previous Sidebar 'pin/unpin' mechanism is removed the Sidebar now disappears completely using either the red arrow icon or the Desktop button
- the Track Info link leads to a DRF web page with info about each track (e.g. track layout, location, weather, stretch run length, racing schedule, takeout rates)
- -left-click on Exit button to **Exit**; right-click to **Restart** RDSS
- the Screen Capture button runs the Windows built-in SnippingTool which helps you capture portions of the screen to print, to cut and paste into Word or WordPad documents, or to Save to file for placing in website messages. This Windows tool is part of Windows Vista and Windows 7, but not Windows XP. If nothing happens when you click the button it means you don't have that Windows tool (though you can download it: Google 'Windows XP Snipping Tool').

2. Past Performances Original Screen Layout.



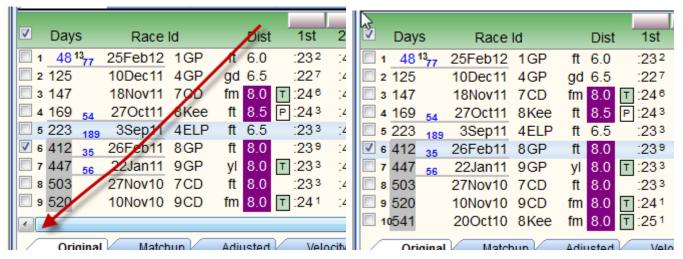
- the **Layoff Separato**r appears whenever pacelines are separated by 30 days or more, when the **Interval** between races also appears (in blue)
- the interval between every race appears when you hover the mouse over the Days column
- (note: the last Workout since the previous race, if any, still appears as a superscript to the right of the Days unchanged)
- the **Adjusted SR** is shown in a 'graphical' layout, with higher values to the right, the highest value in **bold**. Dirt races show in black, Turf races in green, and Polytrack races in this colour.
- Layoffs between races of 30 days or more show the Layoff Separator.
- the **Differential** between highest Adjusted SR is shown to the right of the SR (i.e. the highest SR has a differential of 0)
- use this new Adjusted SR layout to help identify form cycles, improve/decline/return to

previous peaks, etc

- if you don't want to see ANY of this adjusted data on your Original PP display (including Pace of Horse/Race and Perceptor Total), you can Hide it by clicking on the **Hide/Show** button (above the **Adj**. Column text).
- a previous bug in one of the Calibration Handicapping 'moves' (Stretch Run Extention SRE) described here, is corrected
- you can hide ALL 'moves' markups by unchecking the 'Moves' box on the Configure Tab (see Config Screen changes, below)
- if your screen is not wide enough to show all the data on a given display, you can either Hide the Sidebar, and/or (if still not enough width) you can enable 'horizontal sliders' on your data screens by checking 'Show Horizontal Scrollbars' on the Configure Tab. (Note: reducing the font Zoom setting on the Configure screen also displays more data).

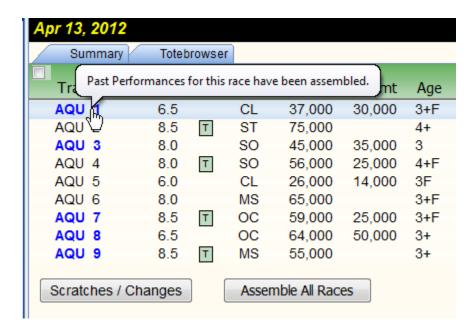
With Horizontal Scrollbars

- the Tabs captioned Form and Matchup have been removed, Form because the info on it is now on the Original screen, and Matchup because the idea needs more work (identifying gain/loss of Position and Beaten Lengths over a race) and will re-appear in some form in the future.

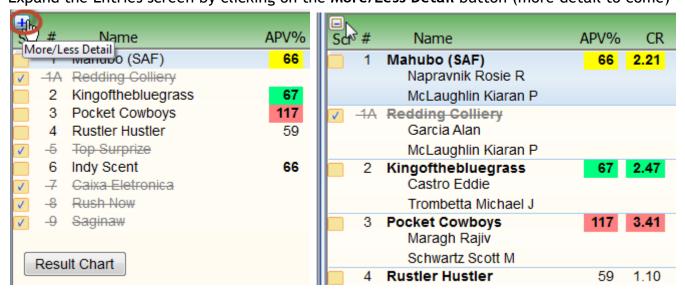
3. Card Summary Screen



- Races which have been accessed before (and thus the PPs 'assembled') show in blue.
- you can assemble all the PPs for a card using the **Assemble all Races** button (eventually this will also be an option in the Data Centre)
- access today's **Changes/Scratches** via a button which loads the Track's Equibase Changes web

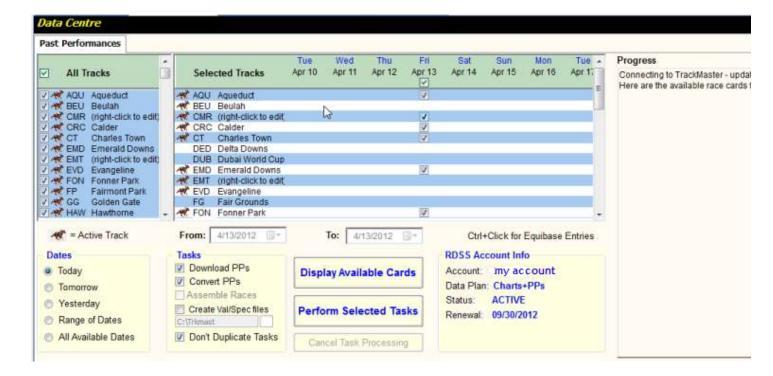
4. Entries Screen

Expand the Entries screen by clicking on the More/Less Detail button (more detail to come)

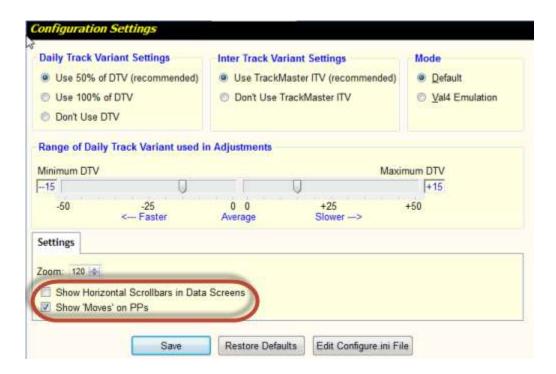


5. Data Centre

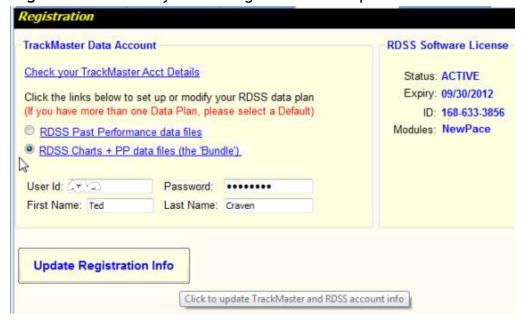
Layout is reorganized and simplified. **Calendars** available when **Range of Dates** chosen, then they drop-down. **Progress** window displays either at the right or below, depending on your screen resolution.



6. **Configure Tab.** Layout is reorganized and simplified. If you want to show Horizontal Sliders in your PP data screens (because your screen is not wide enough for all the data, even after hiding the Sidebar), check **Show Horizontal Scrollbars** (then click Save). If you want to hide the 'moves' markups on the PP Original Tab (coloured underlines showing gains of beaten lengths or positions), uncheck **Show 'Moves' on PPs**.



7. Registration Tab. Layout is reorganized and simplified.



8. **Paceline Selection Strategy Screen.** Layout is reorganized to appear better on smaller screens.
