



## SYNERGISM II

### INTRODUCES PERCENT MEDIAN

In a research program spearheaded by client Jay Elliott of San Diego, the daily, sometimes hourly, deviations in percent early made it impracticable as a modeling tool for many clients at certain tracks. For more sophisticated users, wise in the interpretation of parameters, percent Early is still a potent weapon. But for others, especially those who play a wider variety of races, PERCENT MEDIAN becomes a most important development.

The VC formula, as presented by Barry Bybee of Seattle, proved effective but, ironically provided TOO LITTLE separation for most users to efficiently interpret. A differential of only 1.76 between two horses running six furlongs two full seconds apart did not have the desired positive effect on clients who had some difficulty in pattern recognition.


Percent MED. became the most positive compromise.

In reviewing the performance of Percent MED over a protracted period at Belmont Park, we see the effectiveness of percent MED in action. Only six deviations from fixed parameters in 55 races.

At AKSARBEN in Omaha, in a two racing week review, not ONE winner came from a pace line analysis where the percent MED exceeded 70. By trusting this parameter a large number of public-perceived winners were discarded with resultant high mutuels for our clients using percent MED.

By reducing the range, Energy modeling becomes more significant and more predictive. The precise VC formula did not provide ENOUGH

differential between extremes. By modifying it to %MED, major deviations became more apparent while minor ones, such as that between A & B were substantially reduced.

## SYNERGISM II

WITH % MEDIAN

Here are four additional Synergism II Readouts, all from the same day of the 1988 Del Mar Meet.

Note that in the race won by HIDDEN that two contenders have MED Energy figures exceeding 70%. Note also that we see NO Del Mar winners at ANY distance with a MED of 70% or over. While this a a CURRENT statistic it has been a predictable factor since the beginning of the meet and has also been vital at Saratoga, Aksarben and Long-acres.

Synergism II utilizes advanced Auto-Adjust formulae that make this feature even more accurate than in Synergism I. The Sprint to Route Auto-Adjust evaluates Sprinters stretching out more accurately so that these horses no longer look like automatic wagers.

Synergism II goes a long way toward eliminating TIES, especially in Factor W. Where ties STILL exist there is a good reason, as in the above race. They indicate that contenders are EQUAL in their ability to handle the EARLY LATE Pace match-up. However, with the addition of an unweighted TT formula, LATE PACE and the DR Factor, ties are easily broken.

THE FRACTIONAL DECELERATION AXIS

All too many clients are selecting by a set of numbers ONLY. In so doing they ignore certain obvious aspects of DECELERATION they should be perceiving through the Match-Up. Races are won NOT just by Velocity figures. How a horse DECELERATES relative to its TOTAL ENERGY must be of paramount consideration


This is true at ALL distances but is especially acute in longer routes and in turf races.

Current racing literature is replete with chapters on the importance of EARLY "Speed." When we become overly focussed in this area we often forget that a certain measure of energy is required LATE no matter what the early fractions.

The Fractional Deceleration Axis is an ideal tool for spotting unfavorable deceleration relationships in any portion of the race.

To use it merely create a reasonable pace of race. It need not be reflective of any REAL PACE, so long as the 0 fractions entered are relative. You don't want them too fast or too slow - merely relative. This way most of your entries will be ABOVE OR BELOW your pace line as the race progresses.

The several examples included should give you a good idea of how I used it with effective results.



While these readouts are from the advanced ENERGY program, it would NOT have been necessary to use ANY program to eliminate RAN A ROUTE.

The Deceleration Axis does this for us.



PROJECTING SPRINTERS INTO ROUTES

In projecting a sprinter into a route the unanswerable question will always be: "Can the horse carry its velocity over the distance? Can it properly distribute its total Energy?

Unless the horse has previous route experience visible in its Past Performance Chart, we can only project its route POTENTIAL. To do this we must first compare the sprinter to TODAY'S fastest Router.

EXAMPLE: Today's distance: 8.5 furlongs.

Router: Mile & one-sixteenth.

R:	<u>1F</u> 46	<u>2C</u> 1:11:1	<u>3F</u> 32:1	<u>FINAL</u> 1:43:2

Now the Sprinter. For simplicity sake we'll make these both wire-to-wire winners. However, that's not important since we will ALWAYS USE PACE OF RACE.

Now watch this:

$46/22 = 2.09$ . That's the Percentile relationship of the Sprinter's first fraction to the router's.

$$22 \times 2.09 = 45.98 \text{ or } 46.$$

$$1:11:1 = 71.2. \text{ So } 1:11:2(\text{use tenths}) / 45:2 = 1.57.$$

$$1.57 \times 45.2 = 70.964 \text{ or } 71. (1:11)$$

The third fraction here is not so simple since we must FIRST convert the Sprint quarter mile final fraction to a 5 16ths Final fraction, per the mile and one sixteenth distance.

To do this we convert the times to feet per second:

$$1320/ 24.8 = 53.22. \quad 1650 \text{ ft. (the final 5 16ths)} \\ \text{divided by } 53.22 = 31:00$$

So now using feet per second we divide 32.2 by 31 for:

$$1.03. 31 \times 1.03 = 31.93. \text{ Using 10ths this is just a}$$

shade under 32. In order to make this procedure effective you cannot merely equate your sprinter to the best router. We performed that function just to show you HOW it was done.

You will need to test the multiplier on a number of sprinters who have successfully negotiated routes at your track(s). Once your multiplier has been established as realistically effective, USE it as a constant.

In southern California we have found the above formula is fairly dependable IF the sprinter can stretch out.





### YOU CALL THE RACE

A handicapping analysis and match-up technique using the most formidable computer program of all:

#### EYEBALL SCAN

We first tried this procedure at a Beaumont Clinic dedicated to Win Therapy. Persons who had convinced themselves they had little cognisance or insight into how a race would be run, found themselves exceeding in an area where they thought they were inadequate.

For those who beg for RULES, THIS procedure has some:

- 1 - You MUST do this BEFORE the race, with NO knowledge of the results.
- 2 - Allow yourself just 6 MINUTES for pre-race notations and analysis.
- 3 - Now, out-loud, just like your favorite track announcer, CALL THE RACE from starting gate to wire. Include as many as the top 5 by position at each call, including the stretch. Some will be able to get it down to four, then Three, as your skills improve.
- 4- Allow yourself NO longer than THREE TIMES the actual running time of the race to make your position calls and to fill out the form.  
i.e. A six furlong race with a projected running time of 1:12 should take NO MORE than THREE MINUTES and 36 seconds
- 5- When your time is up STOP. Seek improvements in subsequent races.
- 6- TIME yourself exactly. Do not Fudge.  
Soon you'll be able to CALL THE RACE in just a little over the time it takes to run. Allowing for your having to write down your observations. (even as your track announcer does.)

THE OBJECT: Get the WINNER and ultimately the PLACE horse in your FINAL TOP 5.
